BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION. -- One million five hundred thousand dollars (\$1,500,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the state housing authority of the economic development department for expenditure in fiscal year 1998 for the purpose of providing transitional housing for victims of domestic violence, the homeless and persons exiting the prison system. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 1998 shall revert to the general fund.
