19	THE STATUTESWhen used in the statutes, "Indian country"
20	means:
21	A. all land within the limits of any reservation of
22	an Indian nation, tribe or pueblo under the jurisdiction of the
23	United States government, notwithstanding the issuance of any
24	patent and including rights of way running through the
25	reservation;

1	B. all dependent Indian communities within the
2	borders of New Mexico whether within the original or
3	subsequently acquired territory;
4	C. all Indian allotments, the Indian titles to which
5	have not been extinguished, including rights of way running
6	through the allotments; and
7	D. any lands, title to which is either held by the
8	United States in trust for the benefit of any Indian nation,
9	tribe, pueblo or tribal member or is held by any Indian nation,
10	tribe, pueblo or tribal member subject to a restriction by the
11	United States against alienation."
12	Section 2. EMERGENCYIt is necessary for the public
13	peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.
