16	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
17	Section 1. SEVERANCE TAX BONDSPURPOSE FOR WHICH ISSUED
18	APPROPRIATION OF PROCEEDSThe state board of finance may issue
19	and sell severance tax bonds in compliance with the Severance
20	Tax Bonding Act in an amount not exceeding one million five
21	hundred thousand dollars (\$1,500,000) when the New Mexico office
22	of Indian affairs certifies the need for the issuance of the
23	bonds. The state board of finance shall schedule the issuance
24	and sale of the bonds in the most expeditious and economical
25	manner possible upon a finding by the board that the project has

1 been developed sufficiently to justify the issuance and that the project can proceed to contract within a reasonable time. 2 The state board of finance shall further take the appropriate steps 3 necessary to comply with the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as 4 amended. The proceeds from the sale of the bonds are 5 6 appropriated to the New Mexico office of Indian affairs for the purpose of planning, designing, constructing, furnishing and 7 equipping an environmental laboratory for the Taos pueblo 8 9 located in Taos county. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance 10 remaining at the end of fiscal year 2000 shall revert to the severance tax bonding fund. If the New Mexico office of Indian 11 12 affairs has not certified the need for the issuance of the bonds 13 by the end of fiscal year 1999, the authorization provided in 14 this section shall be void.

Section 2. EMERGENCY.--It is necessary for the public peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.
