17	Section 1. PUNITIVE DAMAGES AWARDPERCENTAGE OF AWARD
18	DEDICATED TO INDIGENT REPRESENTATION FUNDSIf punitive damages
19	are awarded to a party in a civil action, the party who receives
20	the punitive damages award shall retain fifty percent of the
21	award. Twenty-five percent of the punitive damages award shall
22	be deposited in the civil indigent representation fund and
23	twenty-five percent of the punitive damages award shall be
24	deposited in the criminal indigent representation fund.
25	Section 2. CIVIL INDIGENT REPRESENTATION FUND CREATED

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A. There is created in the state treasury the "civil indigent representation fund" to be administered by the administrative office of the courts.

B. Balances in the civil indigent representation fund may be expended by the administrative office of the courts for the purpose of increasing the availability of civil legal services to indigent persons. Balances in the fund shall be expended by the administrative office of the courts in an equitable manner throughout the state, upon a showing of need by applicants for money from the fund.

C. Balances in the civil indigent representation fund shall not revert at the end of any fiscal year.

D. Payments from the civil indigent representation fund shall be made upon vouchers issued and signed by the director of the administrative office of the courts upon warrants drawn by the secretary of finance and administration.

Section 3. CRIMINAL INDIGENT REPRESENTATION FUND CREATED--ADMINISTRATION--DISTRIBUTION.--

A. There is created in the state treasury the "criminal indigent representation fund" to be administered by the public defender department.

B. Balances in the criminal indigent representation fund may be expended by the public defender department for the purpose of increasing the availability of criminal legal

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1	services to indigent persons. Balances in the fund shall be		
2	expended by the public defender department in an equitable

5	C. Balances in the criminal indigent representation
