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AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL EXPENDITURES: AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF SEVERANCE TAX BONDS FOR ENVIRONMENTAL DESIGN SOLUTIONS TO CRIME IN HOUSE DISTRICT 19 IN BERNALILLO COUNTY; MAKING AN APPROPRIATION: DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SEVERANCE TAX BONDS--PURPOSE FOR WHICH ISSUED--Section 1. APPROPRIATION OF PROCEEDS. -- The state board of finance may issue and sell severance tax bonds in compliance with the Severance Tax Bonding Act in an amount not exceeding one hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$150,000) when the local government division of the department of finance and administration certifies the need for the issuance of the bonds. The state board of finance shall schedule the issuance and sale of the bonds in the most expeditious and economical manner possible upon a finding by the

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board that the project has been developed sufficiently to justify the issuance and that the project can proceed to contract within a reasonable time. The state board of finance shall further take the appropriate steps necessary to comply with the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended. proceeds from the sale of the bonds are appropriated to the local government division for the purpose of initiating crime prevention through environmental design projects, including designing for increased visibility, controlled street access, acquisition of open park land, lighting and other capital improvements for house district 19 located in Bernalillo county. The certification and issuance of bonds is contingent upon the city of Albuquerque seeking the advice of the house district 19 neighborhood associations on what capital improvements should be Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the funded. end of fiscal year 2000 shall revert to the severance tax If the local government division has not bonding fund. certified the need for the issuance of the bonds by the end of fiscal year 1999, the authorization provided in this section shall be void.

EMERGENCY. -- It is necessary for the public Section 2. peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.
