22	the issuance of the bonds. The state board of finance shall
23	schedule the issuance and sale of the bonds in the most

1 justify the issuance and that the project can proceed to contract within a reasonable time. The state board of finance 2 shall further take the appropriate steps necessary to comply 3 with the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended. The 4 proceeds from the sale of the bonds are appropriated to the 5 6 local government division for the purpose of designing, constructing, equipping and furnishing a multipurpose facility 7 in Bluewater located in Cibola county. Any unexpended or 8 9 unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 2000 10 shall revert to the severance tax bonding fund. If the local government division has not certified the need for the issuance 11 12 of the bonds by the end of fiscal year 1999, the authorization 13 provided in this section shall be void.
