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18	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
19	Section 1. SEVERANCE TAX BONDSPURPOSE FOR WHICH ISSUED
20	APPROPRIATION OF PROCEEDSThe state board of finance may issue
21	and sell severance tax bonds in compliance with the Severance
22	Tax Bonding Act in an amount not exceeding one million five
23	hundred thousand dollars ($\$1$, 500, 000) when the office of
24	cultural affairs certifies the need for the issuance of the
25	bonds. The state board of finance shall schedule the issuance

1 and sale of the bonds in the most expeditious and economical manner possible upon a finding by the board that the project has 2 been developed sufficiently to justify the issuance and that the 3 project can proceed to contract within a reasonable time. The 4 state board of finance shall further take the appropriate steps 5 6 necessary to comply with the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as 7 amended. The proceeds from the sale of the bonds are appropriated to the office of cultural affairs for the purpose 8 9 of designing, developing, constructing and equipping permanent 10 exhibits at the New Mexico farm and ranch heritage museum 11 located in Dona Ana county. Any unexpended or unencumbered 12 balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 2000 shall revert to 13 the severance tax bonding fund. If the office of cultural 14 affairs has not certified the need for the issuance of the bonds by the end of fiscal year 1999, the authorization provided in 15 16 this section shall be void.

Section 2. EMERGENCY.--It is necessary for the public peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.

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
