16	Section 1. SEVERANCE TAX BONDSPURPOSE FOR WHICH ISSUED
17	APPROPRIATION OF PROCEEDSThe state board of finance may issue
18	and sell severance tax bonds in compliance with the Severance
19	Tax Bonding Act in an amount not exceeding five hundred thousand
20	dollars (\$500,000) when the local government division of the
21	department of finance and administration certifies the need for
22	the issuance of the bonds. The state board of finance shall
23	schedule the issuance and sale of the bonds in the most
24	expeditious and economical manner possible upon a finding by the
25	board that the project has been developed sufficiently to

1 justify the issuance and that the project can proceed to contract within a reasonable time. The state board of finance 2 shall further take the appropriate steps necessary to comply 3 with the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended. The 4 proceeds from the sale of the bonds are appropriated to the 5 6 local government division for the purpose of planning, designing and constructing an athletic field and complex located in Grant 7 Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the 8 county. 9 end of fiscal year 2000 shall revert to the severance tax 10 bonding fund. If the local government division has not 11 certified the need for the issuance of the bonds by the end of 12 fiscal year 1999, the authorization provided in this section 13 shall be void.

Section 2. EMERGENCY.--It is necessary for the public peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.
