17	Section 1. SEVERANCE TAX BONDSPURPOSE FOR WHICH ISSUED
18	APPROPRIATION OF PROCEEDSThe state board of finance may issue
19	and sell severance tax bonds in compliance with the Severance
20	Tax Bonding Act in an amount not exceeding one hundred twenty-
21	five thousand dollars (\$125,000) when the department of health
22	certifies the need for the issuance of the bonds. The state
23	board of finance shall schedule the issuance and sale of the
24	bonds in the most expeditious and economical manner possible
25	upon a finding by the board that the project has been developed

sufficiently to justify the issuance and that the project can 1 proceed to contract within a reasonable time. The state board 2 of finance shall further take the appropriate steps necessary to 3 comply with the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended. The 4 proceeds from the sale of the bonds are appropriated to the 5 department of health for the purpose of making emergency 6 repairs, in order to comply with pertinent fire and safety 7 standards, to Fort Bayard medical center located in Grant 8 county. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the 9 end of fiscal year 2000 shall revert to the severance tax 10 bonding fund. If the department of health has not certified the 11 need for the issuance of the bonds by the end of fiscal year 12 1999, the authorization provided in this section shall be void. 13 Section 2.
