15	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
16	Section 1. SEVERANCE TAX BONDSAUTHORIZATIONS
17	APPROPRIATION OF PROCEEDS
18	A. The state board of finance may issue and sell
19	severance tax bonds in compliance with the Severance Tax Bonding
20	Act in an amount not to exceed the total of the amounts
21	authorized for purposes specified in Sections 2 through 7 of
22	this act. The state board of finance shall schedule the
23	issuance and sale of the bonds in the most expeditious and
24	economical manner possible upon a finding by the board that the
25	project has been developed sufficiently to justify the issuance

and that the project can proceed to contract within a reasonable time. The state board of finance shall further take the appropriate steps necessary to comply with the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended. Proceeds from the sale of the bonds are appropriated for the purposes specified in Sections 2 through 7 of this act.

B. The agencies named in Sections 2 through 7 of this act shall certify to the state board of finance when the money from the proceeds of the severance tax bonds authorized in this section is needed for the purposes specified in the applicable section of this act.

C. If the specified agency has not certified the need for the issuance of the bonds by the end of fiscal year
1999, the authorization provided in this act shall be void.

D. Unless otherwise specified in this act, any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining from the proceeds of severance tax bonds issued pursuant to Sections 2 through 7 of this act at the end of fiscal year 2000 shall revert to the severance tax bonding fund.

Section 2. SEVERANCE TAX BONDS--STATE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC EDUCATION--PURPOSES.--Pursuant to the provisions of Section 1 of this act, upon certification by the state department of public education that the need exists for the issuance of the bonds, the following amounts are appropriated to the state department of public education for the following purposes:

A. four hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$450,000) for planning, designing, constructing and equipping or purchasing, installing and equipping classrooms for the alternative high school in the Santa Fe public school district located in Santa Fe county;

B. three hundred ninety-eight thousand dollars (\$398,000) to purchase and install educational technology and theater and dance floor equipment for the Santa Fe public schools' dropout prevention program in Santa Fe county; and

C. five hundred twenty thousand dollars (\$520,000) to purchase and install educational technology for the Santa Fe public schools' comprehensive student and staff database program in Santa Fe county.

Section 3. SEVERANCE TAX BONDS--LOCAL GOVERNMENT DIVISION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND ADMINISTRATION--PURPOSE.--Pursuant to the provisions of Section 1 of this act, upon certification by the local government division of the department of finance and administration that the need exists for the issuance of the bonds, three million eighteen thousand dollars (\$3,018,000) is appropriated to the local government division of the department of finance and administration for the purpose of constructing, equipping and furnishing a school-community library in Eldorado located in Santa Fe county.

Section 4. SEVERANCE TAX BONDS--NEW MEXICO SCHOOL FOR THE DEAF--PURPOSE.--Pursuant to the provisions of Section 1 of this

act, upon certification by the board of regents of the New Mexico school for the deaf that the need exists for the issuance of the bonds, five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000) is appropriated to the board of regents of the New Mexico school for the deaf for the purpose of campus improvements, including roof repairs, completion of construction of the library and dormitory, for equipping the television-media studio, for purchasing vehicles for student transportation and for maintenance at the New Mexico school for the deaf located in Santa Fe county.

Section 5. SEVERANCE TAX BONDS--SANTA FE COMMUNITY COLLEGE--PURPOSE.--Pursuant to the provisions of Section 1 of this act, upon certification by the community college board of Santa Fe community college that the need exists for the issuance of the bonds, two million dollars (\$2,000,000) is appropriated to the community college board of Santa Fe community college for the purpose of planning, designing, constructing and equipping an instructional technology center at Santa Fe community college located in Santa Fe county.

Section 6. SEVERANCE TAX BONDS--OFFICE OF CULTURAL AFFAIRS--PURPOSE.--Pursuant to the provisions of Section 1 of this act, upon certification by the office of cultural affairs that the need exists for the issuance of the bonds, nine hundred thousand dollars (\$900,000) is appropriated to the office of cultural affairs for the purpose of making improvements to the

Section 7. SEVERANCE TAX BONDS--STATE HIGHWAY AND TRANSPORTATION DEPARTMENT--PURPOSES.--Pursuant to the provisions of Section 1 of this act, upon certification by the state highway and transportation department that the need exists for the issuance of the bonds, the following amounts are appropriated to the state highway and transportation department for the following purposes:

9 A. six hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$650,000) for
10 the purpose of planning, designing and making improvements to
11 Botulph road, including necessary drainage and sewer
12 improvements, in the city of Santa Fe located in Santa Fe
13 county;

B. thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000) for improvements to county road 60A at the Canada Ancha crossing located in Santa Fe county; and

C. eighteen thousand dollars (\$18,000) for improvements to county road 69 at the Arroyo Hondo crossing located in Santa Fe county.

Section 8. EMERGENCY.--It is necessary for the public peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.
