17	Section 1. SEVERANCE TAX BONDSPURPOSE FOR WHICH ISSUED
18	APPROPRIATION OF PROCEEDSThe state board of finance may issue
19	and sell severance tax bonds in compliance with the Severance
20	Tax Bonding Act in an amount not exceeding one hundred twenty
21	thousand dollars ($\$120,000$) when the state highway and
22	transportation department certifies the need for the issuance of
23	the bonds. The state board of finance shall schedule the
24	issuance and sale of the bonds in the most expeditious and
25	economical manner possible upon a finding by the board that the

1 project has been developed sufficiently to justify the issuance and that the project can proceed to contract within a reasonable 2 The state board of finance shall further take the 3 time. appropriate steps necessary to comply with the Internal Revenue 4 5 Code of 1986, as amended. The proceeds from the sale of the 6 bonds are appropriated to the state highway and transportation department for the purpose of chip sealing approximately three 7 miles of Quay county road AF located in Quay county. 8 Any 9 unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of 10 fiscal year 2000 shall revert to the severance tax bonding fund. 11 If the state highway and transportation department has not 12 certified the need for the issuance of the bonds by the end of 13 fiscal year 1999, the authorization provided in this section 14 shall be void.

Section 2. EMERGENCY.--It is necessary for the public peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.
