19	private place where a health care worker performs health care
20	services and includes hospitals, clinics, doctors' offices,
21	dentists' offices and any private premises in which a health
22	care worker is actually performing a health care service.
23	Section 3. DETENTION BY SECURITY OFFICERIf a special or
24	security officer has probable cause to believe that a person has
25	committed a crime at a health care facility, the officer may
