Any unexpended or unencumbered balance 11 remaining at the end of fiscal year 2000 shall revert to the 12 severance tax bonding fund. If the state highway and 13 transportation department has not certified the need for the 14 issuance of the bonds by the end of fiscal year 1999, the 15 authorization provided in this section shall be void.
