19	and sell severance tax bonds in compliance with the Severance
20	Tax Bonding Act in an amount not exceeding three hundred
21	thousand dollars (\$300,000) when the department of health
22	certifies the need for the issuance of the bonds. The state
23	board of finance shall schedule the issuance and sale of the
24	bonds in the most expeditious and economical manner possible
25	upon a finding by the board that the project has been developed

1 sufficiently to justify the issuance and that the project can proceed to contract within a reasonable time. The state board 2 of finance shall further take the appropriate steps necessary to 3 comply with the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended. The 4 proceeds from the sale of the bonds are appropriated to the 5 6 department of health for the purpose of renovating a facility for a vocational program for developmentally disabled adults in 7 Belen located in Valencia county. Any unexpended or 8 9 unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 2000 10 shall revert to the severance tax bonding fund. If the department of health has not certified the need for the issuance 11 12 of the bonds by the end of fiscal year 1999, the authorization 13 provided in this section shall be void.

Section 2. EMERGENCY.--It is necessary for the public peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.
