AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR YOUTH SELF-ESTEEM PROJECTS AT
CERTAIN COMMUNITY CENTERS IN BERNALILLO COUNTY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION. -- One hundred thirty-three
thousand dollars (\$133,000) is appropriated from the general
fund to the department of health for expenditure in fiscal year
1998 for the purpose of funding a program through the
partnership for substance abuse prevention for a youth
initiative project at Westgate, Wells Park, Dennis Chavez and
Westside community centers to help at-risk school-age youth to
develop self-esteem through culturally based instruction in
drama, art, dance, music, chess and computer educational and
vocational programs using internet-based resources. Any
unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of
