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16	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
17	Section 1. SEVERANCE TAX BONDSPURPOSES FOR WHICH
18	ISSUEDAPPROPRIATION OF PROCEEDS
19	A. The state board of finance may issue and sell
20	severance tax bonds in compliance with the Severance Tax Bonding
21	Act in an amount not exceeding two hundred fifty-six thousand
22	dollars (\$256,000) when the state department of public education
23	certifies the need for the issuance of the bonds. The state
24	board of finance shall schedule the issuance and sale of the
25	bonds in the most expeditious and economical manner possible

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upon a finding by the board that the project has been developed sufficiently to justify the issuance and that the project can proceed to contract within a reasonable time. The state board of finance shall further take the appropriate steps necessary to comply with the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended. The proceeds from the sale of the bonds are appropriated to the state department of public education in the following amounts for the following purposes:

(1) one hundred twenty-six thousand dollars
(\$126,000) to purchase two double-wide mobile homes for use as residences for qualified instructional staff for Independent
School District No. 1 in Catron county;

 (2) fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) to design and construct wiring improvements for district school buildings for Independent School District No. 1 in Catron county; and

(3) eighty thousand dollars (\$80,000) topurchase an activity bus for Independent School District No. 1in Catron county.

B. If the state department of public education has

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	1	not certified the need for the issuance of the bonds by the end
	2	of fiscal year 1999, the authorization provided in this section
	3	shall be void. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining
	4	from the proceeds of severance tax bonds issued pursuant to
	5	Subsection A of this section at the end of fiscal year 2000
	6	shall revert to the severance tax bonding fund.
	7	Section 2. EMERGENCYIt is necessary for the public
	8	peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.
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
