17	"38-3-3. CHANGE OF VENUE IN CIVIL AND CRIMINAL CASES
18	A. The venue in all civil and criminal cases shall
19	be changed <u>by transfer</u> , upon motion, to [some] <u>a</u> county free
20	from exception:
21	(1) whenever the judge is interested in the
22	result of the case or is related to or has been counsel for any
23	of the parties; or
24	(2) when the party moving for a change files in
25	the case an affidavit of himself, his agent or attorney, that he

1	believes he cannot obtain a fair trial in the county in which
2	the case is pending because:
3	(a) the adverse party has undue influence
4	over the minds of the inhabitants of the county; [ <del>or</del> ]

7	(c) because of public excitement or local
8	prejudice in the county in regard to the case or the questions
9	involved [ <del>therein</del> ] <u>in the case</u> , an impartial jury cannot be
