AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL EXPENDITURES; CHANGING THE PURPOSE AND EXTENDING THE EXPENDITURE PERIOD OF A GENERAL FUND APPROPRIATION FOR A HEALTH CLINIC IN ARTESIA IN EDDY COUNTY; MAKING AN APPROPRIATION; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. GENERAL FUND--DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND

ADMINISTRATION--CHANGING THE PURPOSE--EXTENDING EXPENDITURE

PERIOD--APPROPRIATION.--The balance of the general fund

appropriation made to the local government division of the

department of finance and administration pursuant to Subsection

JJ of Section 6 of Chapter 147 of Laws 1994 for designing,

planning, constructing, equipping and furnishing a community

health clinic in the city of Artesia located in Eddy county

shall not be expended for its original purpose but is

appropriated to the local government division for designing, planning, constructing, equipping or furnishing a community health clinic, including the option of upgrading to a modular building, in the city of Artesia in Eddy county. The period of time for expenditure of the appropriation is extended through fiscal year 1999. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 1999 shall revert to the general fund.

Section 2. EMERGENCY. -- It is necessary for the public peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.
