Section 2. SEVERANCE TAX BONDS--DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND ADMINISTRATION--CHANGE IN PURPOSE--APPROPRIATION.--The balance of severance tax bonds appropriated to the local government division of the department of finance and administration pursuant to Subsection G of Section 5 of Chapter 4 of Laws 1996 (1st S.S.) for the purpose of improving or updating equipment for the Moriarty fire department located in Torrance county shall not be expended for its original purpose but is reauthorized and appropriated to the local government division for the purpose of improving or updating equipment for the fire department located in northeast Torrance county.

Section 3. GENERAL FUND--DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND ADMINISTRATION--CHANGE IN PURPOSE--APPROPRIATION.--The balance of the general fund appropriation made to the local government division of the department of finance and administration pursuant to Subsection J of Section 21 of Chapter 4 of Laws 1996 (1st S.S.) for the purpose of acquiring new vehicles for the Torrance county sheriff's department shall not be expended for its original purpose but is appropriated to the local government division for the purpose of acquiring new vehicles and repairing existing vehicles for the Torrance county sheriff's department.

Section 4. EMERGENCY.--It is necessary for public peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.
