16	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
17	Section 1. SEVERANCE TAX BONDSPURPOSE FOR WHICH ISSUED
18	APPROPRIATION OF PROCEEDSThe state board of finance may issue
19	and sell severance tax bonds in compliance with the Severance
20	Tax Bonding Act in an amount not exceeding nine hundred fifty
21	thousand dollars (\$950,000) when the state highway and
22	transportation department certifies the need for the issuance of
23	the bonds. The state board of finance shall schedule the
24	issuance and sale of the bonds in the most expeditious and
25	economical manner possible upon a finding by the board that the

1 project has been developed sufficiently to justify the issuance and that the project can proceed to contract within a reasonable 2 The state board of finance shall further take the 3 time. appropriate steps necessary to comply with the Internal Revenue 4 Code of 1986, as amended. The proceeds from the sale of the 5 6 bonds are appropriated to the state highway and transportation department for the purpose of planning, designing or 7 constructing highway safety improvements to the intersection of 8 9 United States highway 666 and United States highway 64 in 10 Shiprock located in Juan county. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 2000 shall revert to 11 12 the severance tax bonding fund. If the state highway and 13 transportation department has not certified the need for the issuance of the bonds by the end of fiscal year 1999, the 14 15 authorization provided in this section shall be void.

Section 2. EMERGENCY.--It is necessary for the public peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.
