4	C. For a one-time fee of twenty-five dollars			
5	(\$25.00), which shall be in addition to the regular motor			
6	vehicle registration fees, any owner of a motor vehicle that is			
7	thirty or more years old may apply to the division to use a			
8	year-of-manufacture plate on his vehicle.			
9	D. Upon the sale or transfer of a motor vehicle			
10	bearing a year-of-manufacture plate, the plate shall remain with			
11	the vehicle and be transferred to the new owner."
