The state board of finance 2 shall further take the appropriate steps necessary to comply 3 with the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended. The 4 5 proceeds from the sale of the bonds are appropriated to the 6 department of environment for the purpose of constructing a wastewater system for La Mesa-San Miguel located in Dona Ana 7 Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the 8 county. 9 end of fiscal year 2000 shall revert to the severance tax 10 bonding fund. If the department of environment has not 11 certified the need for the issuance of the bonds by the end of 12 fiscal year 1999, the authorization provided in this section 13 shall be void. 14

Section 2. EMERGENCY.--It is necessary for the public peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.
