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15	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
16	Section 1. SEVERANCE TAX BONDSAUTHORIZATIONS
17	APPROPRIATION OF PROCEEDS
18	A. The state board of finance may issue and sell
19	severance tax bonds in compliance with the Severance Tax Bonding
20	Act in an amount not to exceed the total of the amounts
21	authorized for purposes specified in Sections 2 through 4 of
22	this act. The state board of finance shall schedule the
23	issuance and sale of the bonds in the most expeditious and
24	economical manner possible upon a finding by the board that the
25	project has been developed sufficiently to justify the issuance

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and that the project can proceed to contract within a reasonable time. The state board of finance shall further take the appropriate steps necessary to comply with the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended. Proceeds from the sale of the bonds are appropriated for the purposes specified in Sections 2 through 4 of this act.

B. The agencies named in Sections 2 through 4 of this act shall certify to the state board of finance when the money from the proceeds of the severance tax bonds authorized in this section is needed for the purposes specified in the applicable section of this act.

C. If the specified agency has not certified the need for the issuance of the bonds by the end of fiscal year 1999, the authorization provided in this act shall be void.

D. Unless otherwise specified in this act, any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining from the proceeds of severance tax bonds issued pursuant to Sections 2 through 4 of this act at the end of fiscal year 2000 shall revert to the severance tax bonding fund.

Section 2. SEVERANCE TAX BONDS--STATE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC EDUCATION--PURPOSE.--Pursuant to the provisions of Section 1 of this act, upon certification by the state department of public education that the need exists for the issuance of the bonds, seventy thousand dollars (\$70,000) is appropriated to the state department of public education to construct an additional

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classroom for and remodel the elementary school in the Cuba independent school district in Sandoval county.

Section 3. SEVERANCE TAX BONDS. -- DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND ADMINISTRATION--PURPOSE. -- Pursuant to the provisions of Section 1 of this act, upon certification by the local government division of the department of finance and administration that the need exists for the issuance of the bonds, fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) is appropriated to the local government division of the department of finance and administration to design, construct and equip repairs to La Jarra community center in Sandoval county.

Section 4. SEVERANCE TAX BONDS--DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENT--PURPOSE.--Pursuant to the provisions of Section 1 of this act, upon certification by the department of environment that the need exists for the issuance of the bonds, five hundred ten thousand dollars (\$510,000) is appropriated to the department of environment for the purpose of planning, designing and constructing the Placitas mutual domestic water and sewer association's centralized wastewater collection and treatment facility in the community of Placitas located in Rio Arriba county.

Section 5. EMERGENCY.--It is necessary for the public peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.

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
