A new section of the Tort Claims Act is enacted Section 1. to read:

"[NEW MATERIAL] LIABILITY--USE OF IRRIGATION DISTRICT LAND FOR RECREATIONAL PURPOSES. -- Nothing in the Tort Claims Act shall be construed as granting waiver of immunity for any damages arising out of the use of property owned or controlled by any irrigation district established pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 73, Article 9, 10 or 11 NMSA 1978, for hunting, fishing, trapping, camping, hiking, sightseeing or any other recreational use, where the irrigation district allows such use without charge or other consideration other than a consideration paid by
