20	A. The following classes of persons shall be
21	prohibited from receiving or holding licenses [under] pursuant

23	[A.] (1) a person who has been convicted of two
24	separate misdemeanor or petty misdemeanor violations of the

the person is restored to the privilege of receiving and holding licenses by the governor or unless the director determines that the person merits the public trust, in which case the person shall receive licenses under reasonable terms and conditions fixed by the director, which shall include that the person pay an administrative penalty of two thousand five hundred dollars (\$2,500) for each license held by that person;

[B.] (2) a person whose [spouse had] family member has been convicted of a felony unless the person [demonstrates that the convicted spouse] provides an affidavit to the liquor director affirming that the convicted family member will have no involvement in the operation, management, profits or finances of the license;

[C.] (3) a minor; or

[D-] (4) a corporation that is not duly qualified to do business in New Mexico, unless the licensee holds a public service license or a nonresident license issued [under] as provided in Section 60-6A-7 NMSA 1978; provided, however, that a corporation that owns stock in a corporation that owns a New Mexico liquor license does not need to be qualified to do business in New Mexico regardless of the size of the ownership interest.

B. As used in this section "family member" means spouse, uncle, aunt, sibling, child or parent of a person or a sibling, child or parent of the spouse of the person."
