The agricultural crops shall be distributed to 21 sick or indigent persons. The corrections department shall 22 cooperate with other departments, public bodies and private 23 landowners as it deems appropriate to develop and implement

policies and procedures and shall provide staffing and

administrative support for the program, including its harvesting and distribution systems.

- B. As part of the inmate work food distribution program, the corrections department shall conduct a harvesting and distribution pilot project commencing July 1, 1997 using minimum-security inmates of state and local correctional facilities. The corrections department shall cooperate with the human services department to establish and implement the food distribution system, policies, procedures or other features of the pilot project.
- C. The pilot project shall be implemented on state or private lands, with the private landowner's consent, that are in proximity to the correctional facilities housing the inmates. Agricultural products harvested through the pilot project shall be distributed only to sick or indigent persons.
- D. The corrections department shall report and make recommendations to the appropriate interim legislative committee not later than November 1, 1998 on whether to continue, discontinue or modify the pilot project.
- E. As used in this section: "agricultural crop" means any owner-donated food or nonfood crop or product grown on land, including firewood.
- Section 2. APPROPRIATION. -- One hundred forty thousand dollars (\$140,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the corrections department for expenditure in fiscal years 1998 and

1999 for the purpose of establishing and operating a food harvesting and distribution pilot project. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 1998 shall not revert. Any unexpended and unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 1999 shall revert to the general fund.
