16	Section 1. SHORT TITLEThis act may be cited as the
17	"Investment in University Excellence Act".
18	Section 2. PURPOSE The purpose of the Investment in
19	University Excellence Act is to encourage the investment of
20	private funds in New Mexico higher education by providing state
21	matching funds to attract private corporate and philanthropic
22	contributions to the state's institutions of higher education as
23	a public-private partnership in university excellence.
24	Section 3. UNIVERSITIES TO ESTABLISH ENDOWMENT PROGRAMS
25	A. The boards of regents of the university of New

Mexico, New Mexico state university, New Mexico institute of mining and technology, New Mexico highlands university, eastern New Mexico university and western New Mexico university may establish endowed faculty chairs, professorships, lectureships and graduate fellowships to carry out the purpose of the Investment in University Excellence Act.

B. Money provided from public and private sources for endowments established pursuant to Subsection A of this section shall not be expended, but shall be invested by the institutions, and the income from the investment shall be used to carry out the provisions of the Investment in University Excellence Act; provided that nothing in this section prohibits an institution from reinvesting income from its endowment.

Section 4. FUND CREATED--ADMINISTRATION. --

A. The "investment in university excellence fund" is created in the state treasury. The money in the fund is appropriated to the commission on higher education for the purposes set forth in the Investment in University Excellence Act and amounts in the fund shall not revert at the end of any fiscal year. Amounts in the fund shall be distributed to the institutions of higher education as provided in Subsection B of this section and as otherwise provided by appropriation of the legislature. The fund shall be administered by the commission on higher education in accordance with the provisions of that act.

An institution of higher education named in Section 3 of the Investment in University Excellence Act shall certify to the commission on higher education that it has received contributions from private sources in an amount equal to the amount requested from the investment in university excellence fund.
