AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR STAFF EXPENSES AT THE NENAHNEZAD
CHAPTER OF THE NAVAJO NATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION. -- One hundred thousand dollars
(\$100,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the New
Mexico office of Indian affairs for expenditure in fiscal year
1998 for the purpose of paying the salaries, benefits and
administrative costs of an environmental planner, a librarian
and maintenance workers for the Nenahnezad chapter of the Navajo
nation. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the
end of fiscal year 1998 shall revert to the general fund.
