REQUESTS FOR BUDGET ADJUSTMENTS--**"6-3-24.** [NEW MATERIAL] AUTHORIZATION REQUIRED--LIMITATIONS.--If specifically authorized by law, a state agency may request a budget adjustment. the law specifically authorizing the budget adjustment allows a larger adjustment:

the annual cumulative effective of division transfers shall not increase or decrease the appropriation to any division by more than seven and one-half percent; and

В. the annual cumulative effect of category transfers shall not increase or decrease the appropriation for any category by more than twenty-five percent."

Section 3. Section 6-3-25 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1992, Chapter 2, Section 3) is amended to read:

"6-3-25. BUDGET ADJUSTMENT PROCEDURE. --

Requests for budget adjustments shall be

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submitted	to	the	stat	e	budget	di vi si on.	The	st	ate	budge	t
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di vi si on	may	appr	ove	a	budget	adj ustment	i f	i t	find	ls:	

- (1) the state agency is specifically authorized by law to request the budget adjustment;
- (2) the budget adjustment furthers the goals of the state agency and is otherwise in the best interest of the citizens of New Mexico;
- (3) the need for the budget adjustment was not foreseen during the session of the legislature that made the initial appropriation and, therefore, it could not have been submitted to the legislature for approval; and
- (4) the budget adjustment is not otherwise contrary to law or to the intent of the legislature.
- [A. Except for federal funds] B. Any budget adjustment request [to transfer, decrease or increase funds] shall be held in abeyance for ten calendar days after the director of the state budget division [of the department of finance and administration] has approved the request and has filed the request with the director of the legislative finance committee or his designee. The request shall be accompanied by the written findings made pursuant to Subsection A of this section and a statement, in writing, of the conditions under which the budget adjustment request is approved, together with justification for approval.
 - [B-] <u>C.</u> If within ten days the director of the

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legislative finance committee or his designee objects to the request, the request shall not go into effect until it is reviewed by the legislative finance committee or a subcommittee of the legislative finance committee at a public hearing held within thirty-five calendar days of receipt of the proposed budget adjustment by the director of the legislative finance committee or his designee. If the state fiscal year ends prior to the date scheduled for a hearing, the request shall go into effect on the last day of the fiscal year. If, at the public hearing, the committee or subcommittee objects to the budget adjustment request, the request shall not go into effect until the director of the state budget division has reconsidered the findings made pursuant to Subsection A of this section.

[C.] D. If within ten days of receipt of a budget adjustment request the director of the legislative finance committee or his designee indicates that no objection will be forthcoming, the proposed budget adjustment request may be implemented immediately. If no objection is made within the required ten days or if no public hearing is held within the required thirty-five days, the request may be implemented."

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
