14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
15	Section 1. APPROPRIATIONSGENERAL FUNDFour million
16	seven hundred sixty-two thousand dollars (\$4,762,000) is
17	appropriated from the general fund to the department of finance
18	and administration for expenditure in fiscal year 1998 for the
19	purpose of providing a salary increase to eligible classified
20	employees in agencies governed by the Personnel Act. In
21	accordance with a variable pay for performance salary matrix as
22	approved by the personnel board and negotiated with the New
23	Mexico state labor coalition, a salary increase of an average
24	two and one-half percent of range midpoint on the eligible
25	classified employee's anniversary date is authorized. This

<u>Underscored mterial = new</u> [bracketed mterial] = delete average increase includes providing annualized lump-sum payments to eligible classified employees whose salaries equal or exceed their salary range maximums. Salary increases shall be effective the first full pay period following the employee's anniversary date. The department of finance and administration shall distribute a sufficient amount to each agency to provide the appropriate increase for those employees whose salaries are received as a result of general fund appropriations in the General Appropriation Act of 1997. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 1998 shall revert to the general fund.

Section 2. APPROPRIATIONS--OTHER STATE FUNDS.--For those state employees whose salaries are referenced in or received as a result of non-general fund appropriations in the General Appropriation Act of 1997, the department of finance and administration shall transfer from the appropriate fund to the appropriate agency the amount required for the salary increases equivalent to those provided for in Section 1 of this act, and such amounts are appropriated for expenditure in fiscal year 1998. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 1998 shall revert to the appropriate fund.
