Section 1. Section 2-12-6 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1993, Chapter 65, Section 15) is amended to read:

DWI OVERSIGHT TASK FORCE CREATED--**"2-12-6.** 

TERMINATION. -- The "DWI oversight task force" is created. task force shall function from the date of its appointment until the first day of December prior to the [second session of the forty-third legislature first session of the forty-fourth legislature."

Section 2. Section 2-12-9 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1993, Chapter 65, Section 18) is amended to read:

"2-12-9. REPORT.--The DWI oversight task force shall make a report of its findings and recommendations for the consideration of the second session of the forty-first legislature, the first session of the forty-second legislature, the second session of the forty-second legislature, the first session of the forty-third legislature, [and] the second session of the forty-third legislature and the first session of the forty-fourth legislature. The reports and suggested legislation shall be made available to the <a href="New Mexico">New Mexico</a> legislative council on or before December 15 preceding each session."

Section 3. EFFECTIVE DATE. -- The effective date of the provisions of this act is July 1, 1997.
