15	Section 1. PUBLIC REGULATION COMMISSIONERSELECTION
16	TERMS
17	A. Public regulation commissioners shall be elected
18	at the general election for staggered four-year terms, beginning
19	on January 1 next following their election; provided that the
20	first election of commissioners and the initial terms of those
21	commissioners shall be as provided in Subsection B of this
22	section.
23	B. Five commissioners shall be elected at the first
24	election of commissioners in 1998. The commissioners elected at
25	the first election shall immediately classify themselves by lot,

1 so that two of the five elected shall hold office for an initial two-year term and three for an initial four-year term. 2 Thereafter, all terms shall be for four years; provided that if 3 a vacancy occurs prior to completion of a term, the vacancy 4 shall be filled for the unexpired term only. 5 **C**. After serving two consecutive terms, including 6 the initial two-year terms of the two commissioners chosen by 7 lot after the first election, a commissioner is ineligible to 8 9 hold office as a commissioner until one full four-year term has intervened. 10 PUBLIC REGULATION COMMISSIONER DISTRICTS. --11 Section 2. 12 A. Public regulation commissioners shall be elected 13 from districts as follows: 14 (1)one commissioner shall be elected from each of the three congressional districts in the state; and 15 16 (2)two commissioners shall be elected statewide. 17 18 B.
