1 comfort and convenience of the municipality and its inhabitants; and 2

С. enforcing obedience to the ordinances by prosecution in the municipal court and metropolitan courts and upon conviction the imposition of: 5

(1)except for those violations of ordinances 6 described in Paragraphs (2), [and] (3) and (4) of this 7 subsection, a fine of not more than five hundred dollars (\$500) 8 9 or imprisonment for not more than ninety days or both;

10 for a violation of an ordinance prohibiting (2) 11 driving a motor vehicle while under the influence of 12 intoxicating liquor or drugs, a fine of not more than one 13 thousand dollars (\$1,000) or imprisonment for not more than 14 three hundred sixty-four days or both; [and]

15 for violations of an industrial user (3) 16 wastewater pretreatment ordinance as required by the United 17 States environmental protection agency, a fine of not more 18 than one thousand dollars (\$1,000) a day for each violation; and

(4) for a violation of a curfew ordinance, a fine of not more than five hundred dollars (\$500) or community service, or both."

1 A. The municipal, magistrate or metropolitan court shall have original exclusive jurisdiction over all Motor 2 Vehicle Code violations, [or] municipal traffic code violations 3 or municipal curfew violations when the person alleged to have 4 committed the violation is a child, with the exception of those 5 6 violations contained in Paragraph (1) of Subsection A of Section [32-2-3] 32A-2-3 NMSA 1978 and all traffic offenses alleged to 7 have been committed by the child arising out of the same 8 9 occurrence pursuant to Subsection B of this section.

B. If the children's court acquires jurisdiction
over a child pursuant to any of those Motor Vehicle Code
violations contained in Paragraph (1) of Subsection A of Section
[32-2-3] 32A-2-3 NMSA 1978, it shall have jurisdiction over all
traffic offenses alleged to have been committed by the child
arising out of the same occurrence.

C. All traffic offenses [which] that the child is found to have committed by the municipal, magistrate or metropolitan court or for which the child is adjudicated delinquent by the children's court shall be subject to the reporting requirements and the suspension and revocation provisions of the Motor Vehicle Code and shall not be subject to the confidentiality provisions of the Delinquency Act.

D. No tribunal may incarcerate any child who has been found guilty of any Motor Vehicle Code <u>violations</u>, [<del>or</del>] municipal traffic code violations <u>or municipal curfew violations</u>
