## AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR INDIAN EDUCATION PROJECTS FOR EXCELLENCE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION. -- One hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the state department of public education for expenditure in fiscal year 1998 for the purpose of continuing New Mexico Indian education center for excellence projects, which include encouraging learning by the development of projects in day schools and public schools to enhance the capabilities of Indian students in reading, writing, math and language skills as well as traditional language and culture. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 1998 shall revert to the general fund.
