AN ACT

RELATING TO PUBLIC SCHOOLS; REQUIRING THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC EDUCATION TO ADOPT PROCEDURES TO ENSURE THAT SCHOOL DISTRICTS COMPLY WITH ACCOUNTING AND BUDGETING REGULATIONS; DIRECTING THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC EDUCATION TO PROMULGATE REGULATIONS REQUIRING SCHOOL DISTRICTS TO SUBMIT ANNUAL ACCOUNTING AND BUDGETING REPORTS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. Section 22-8-5 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1967, Chapter 16, Section 59, as amended) is amended to read:

"22-8-5. MANUAL OF ACCOUNTING AND BUDGETING. --

A. The department shall compile and publish a manual prescribing detailed regulations for a uniform system of accounting and budgeting of funds for all public schools and school districts of the state. The manual of regulations and

1 any revision or amendments thereto shall become effective only
2 upon approval by the state board [~~of education~~] and the
3 legislative finance committee, filing with the state records
4 center and publication. A copy shall also be filed with the
5 department of finance and administration.

6 B. All public schools and school districts shall
7 comply with the regulations prescribed in the manual of
8 accounting and budgeting and shall, upon request, submit
9 additional reports concerning finances to the department. In
10 addition, upon request, all public schools and school districts
11 shall file reports with the department containing pertinent
12 details regarding applications for federal money or federal
13 grants-in-aid or regarding federal money or federal grants-in-
14 aid received, including but not limited to details of programs,
15 matching funds, personnel requirements, salary provisions and
16 program numbers, as indicated in the catalog of federal domestic
17 assistance, of the federal funds applied for and of those
18 received.

19 C. The department shall develop procedures for
20 ensuring that school districts comply with the regulations
21 prescribed in the manual of accounting and budgeting. The
22 department shall require school districts to submit annually a
23 report on the district's internal control policies and
24 procedures. The report shall be submitted with each budget
25 request required pursuant to Section 22-8-12.1 NMSA 1978.

1 include information on the internal control structure for all
2 school district transactions and specify the individuals
3 involved in the accounting and budgeting process during the
4 accounting cycle.

5 [C:] D. Upon request by the department of finance
6 and administration, the legislative finance committee or the
7 legislative education study committee, the [state] department
8 [of public education] shall timely furnish information and data
9 obtained from public schools and school districts pursuant to
10 Subsection B of this section. Additionally, prior to the
11 approval of temporary budgets, the department shall advise each
12 school district and the state auditor of the minimum
13 requirements for independent school district audits for the
14 ensuing fiscal year.
