FOR THE LEGISLATIVE EDUCATION STUDY COMMITTEE

AN ACT

RELATING TO PUBLIC SCHOOL CAPITAL OUTLAY; PROVIDING FOR A STUDY
OF PUBLIC SCHOOL CAPITAL OUTLAY FACILITIES AND INFRASTRUCTURE;
MAKING AN APPROPRIATION; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. TEMPORARY PROVISION--STUDY.--The public school
capital outlay council shall conduct a comprehensive study of
public school capital outlay needs statewide. The study shall
include development of guidelines and standards; an inventory
and assessment of school facilities and infrastructure; cost
estimates for repair, renovation and modernization of existing
facilities; and an estimate of future facility needs. The study
shall assess the equity and efficiency of current state and
local processes used to fund public school facilities and
recommmend an equitable and efficient method by which to meet

1 public school capital outlay needs. A progress report shall be
2 presented to the legislative education study committee and the
3 legislative finance committee by November 1, 1997 and the final
4 report by June 30, 1998.

5 Section 2. APPROPRIATION.--Five hundred thousand dollars
6 (\$500,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the state
7 department of public education for expenditure in fiscal years
8 1997 and 1998 for the purpose of conducting a study of public
9 school capital outlay facilities and infrastructure as provided
10 in Section 1 of this section. Any unexpended or unencumbered
11 balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 1998 shall revert to
12 the general fund.

13 Section 3. EMERGENCY.--It is necessary for the public
14 peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.
