project has been developed sufficiently to justify the issuance 1 and that the project can proceed to contract within a reasonable 2 The state board of finance shall further take the time. 3 appropriate steps necessary to comply with the Internal Revenue 4 Code of 1986, as amended. The proceeds from the sale of the 5 bonds are appropriated to the state highway and transportation 6 department for the purpose of planning and designing 7 improvements to a proposed extension of Lohman avenue in Las 8 Cruces in Dona Ana county. Any unexpended or unencumbered 9 balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 2000 shall revert to 10 the severance tax bonding fund. If the state highway and 11 transportation department has not certified the need for the 12 issuance of the bonds by the end of fiscal year 1999, the 13 authorization provided in this section shall be void. 14 Section 2.
