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17	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
18	Section 1. SEVERANCE TAX BONDSPURPOSE FOR WHICH ISSUED
19	APPROPRIATION OF PROCEEDSThe state board of finance may issue
20	and sell severance tax bonds in compliance with the Severance
21	Tax Bonding Act in an amount not exceeding one million five
22	hundred thousand dollars ( $\$1$ , 500, 000) when the state highway and
23	transportation department certifies the need for the issuance of
23 24	the bonds. The state board of finance shall schedule the
2 <del>4</del> 25	issuance and sale of the bonds in the most expeditious and
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economical manner possible upon a finding by the board that the 1 project has been developed sufficiently to justify the issuance 2 and that the project can proceed to contract within a reasonable 3 time. The state board of finance shall further take the 4 appropriate steps necessary to comply with the Internal Revenue 5 Code of 1986, as amended. The proceeds from the sale of the 6 bonds are appropriated to the state highway and transportation 7 department for the planning, design and acquisition of rights of 8 way for a frontage road from the United States highway 70 and 9 interstate 25 interchange east nearly to the Onate high school 10 in Dona Ana county. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance 11 remaining at the end of fiscal year 2000 shall revert to the 12 severance tax bonding fund. If the state highway and 13 transportation department has not certified the need for the 14 issuance of the bonds by the end of fiscal year 1999, the 15 authorization provided in this section shall be void. 16

Section 2. EMERGENCY.--It is necessary for the public peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.
