17	Section 1. SEVERANCE TAX BONDSPURPOSE FOR WHICH ISSUED						
18	APPROPRIATION OF PROCEEDSThe state board of finance may issue						
19	and sell severance tax bonds in compliance with the Severance						
20	Tax Bonding Act in an amount not exceeding two hundred eighty-						
21	five thousand dollars ($$285,000$) when the board of regents of						
22	the university of New Mexico certifies the need for the issuance						
23	of the bonds. The state board of finance shall schedule the						
24	issuance and sale of the bonds in the most expeditious and						
25	economical manner possible upon a finding by the board that the						

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project has been developed sufficiently to justify the issuance 1 and that the project can proceed to contract within a reasonable 2 The state board of finance shall further take the time. 3 appropriate steps necessary to comply with the Internal Revenue 4 Code of 1986, as amended. The proceeds from the sale of the 5 bonds are appropriated to the board of regents of the university 6 of New Mexico for the purpose of renovating certain facilities 7 at the campus of the Gallup branch of the university of New 8 Mexico located in McKinley county. Any unexpended or 9 unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 2000 10 shall revert to the severance tax bonding fund. If the board of 11 regents of the university of New Mexico has not certified the 12 need for the issuance of the bonds by the end of fiscal year 13 1999, the authorization provided in this section shall be void. 14 Section 2.
