16	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
17	Section 1. SEVERANCE TAX BONDSPURPOSE FOR WHICH ISSUED
18	APPROPRIATION OF PROCEEDSThe state board of finance may issue
19	and sell severance tax bonds in compliance with the Severance
20	Tax Bonding Act in an amount not exceeding eight hundred
21	thousand dollars (\$800,000) when the New Mexico office of Indian
22	affairs certifies the need for the issuance of the bonds. The
23	state board of finance shall schedule the issuance and sale of
24	the bonds in the most expeditious and economical manner possible
25	upon a finding by the board that the project has been developed

sufficiently to justify the issuance and that the project can 1 proceed to contract within a reasonable time. The state board 2 of finance shall further take the appropriate steps necessary to 3 comply with the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended. The 4 proceeds from the sale of the bonds are appropriated to the New 5 Mexico office of Indian affairs for the purpose of planning, 6 preparing the site for, designing and engineering a daycare 7 center in Shiprock located in San Juan county. Any unexpended 8 or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 2000 9 shall revert to the severance tax bonding fund. If the New 10 Mexico office of Indian affairs has not certified the need for 11 the issuance of the bonds by the end of fiscal year 1999, the 12 authorization provided in this section shall be void. 13 Section 2. EMERGENCY.--It is necessary for the public 14 peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately. 15
