1 A sex offender who changes his residence to New Mexico shall register with the county sheriff no later than [forty-five] 2 seven days after establishing residence in this state. When a 3 sex offender registers with the county sheriff, he shall provide 4 the following information: 5 his legal name and any other names or 6 (1)aliases that [the sex offender] he is using or has used; 7 his date of birth; (2)8 9 (3) his social security number; his current address: 10 (4) his place of employment; 11 (5) 12 the sex offense for which he was convicted; (6) 13 and the date and place of his sex offense 14 (7) conviction. 15 16 С. When a sex offender registers with a county sheriff, the sheriff shall obtain: 17 18 a photograph of the sex offender and a (1) 19 complete set of the sex offender's fingerprints; and 20 a description of any tattoos, scars or (2)21 other distinguishing features on the sex offender's body that 22 would assist in identifying the sex offender. 23 When a sex offender who is registered changes his D. residence within the same county, the sex offender shall send 24 25 written notice of his change of address to the county sheriff no . 113623. 1

E. When a sex offender who is registered changes his residence to a new county in New Mexico, the sex offender shall register with the county sheriff of the new county no later than ten days after establishing his new residence. The sex offender shall also send written notice of the change in residence to the county sheriff with whom he last registered no later than ten days after establishing his new residence.

F. A sex offender who willfully fails to comply with the registration requirements set forth in this section is guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be punished by imprisonment for a definite term less than one year or a fine of not more than one thousand dollars (\$1,000) or both.

G. A sex offender who provides false information when complying with the registration requirements set forth in this section is guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be punished by imprisonment for a definite term less than one year or a fine of not more than one thousand dollars (\$1,000) or both."
