1 developed sufficiently to justify the issuance and that the project can proceed to contract within a reasonable time. 2 The state board of finance shall further take the appropriate steps 3 necessary to comply with the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as 4 5 The proceeds from the sale of the bonds are amended. 6 appropriated to the board of regents of eastern New Mexico university for the purpose of remodeling Lea hall at eastern New 7 Mexico university located in Roosevelt county. Any unexpended 8 9 or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 2000 10 shall revert to the severance tax bonding fund. If the board of 11 regents of eastern New Mexico university has not certified the 12 need for the issuance of the bonds by the end of fiscal year 13 1999, the authorization provided in this section shall be void.

Section 2. EMERGENCY.--It is necessary for the public peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.
