MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH FOR A STATEWIDE MATERNAL AND CHILD HEALTH CARE SYSTEM.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION--MATERNAL AND CHILD HEALTH.-Eight hundred eighty thousand dollars (\$880,000) is appropriated
from the general fund to the department of health for
expenditure by the public health division in fiscal year 1998
for the purpose of completing the statewide maternal and child
health care system, including coordinating community agencies;
serving as a statewide clearinghouse; assisting to implement
innovative maternal and child health care programs; providing
technical assistance; and operating county- or area-wide
maternal and child health councils. Any unexpended or
unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 1998
