16	Section 1. Section 22-12-2.1 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1986,
17	Chapter 33, Section 27, as amended) is amended to read:
18	"22-12-2.1. <u>INTERSCHOLASTIC</u> EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITIES
19	STUDENT PARTICIPATION
20	A. A student shall have a 2.0 grade point average on
21	a 4.0 scale, or its equivalent, either cumulatively or for the
22	grading period immediately preceding participation, in order to
23	be eligible to participate in any <u>interscholastic</u>
24	extracurricular activity. For purposes of this section,
25	"grading period" is a period of time not less than six weeks.

The provisions of this subsection shall not apply to special education students placed in class C and class D programs.

B. No student shall be absent from school for school-sponsored <u>interscholastic</u> extracurricular activities in excess of fifteen days per semester, and no class may be missed in excess of fifteen times per semester.

7 C. The provisions of Subsections A and B of this
8 section apply [to all] only to interscholastic extracurricular
9 activities.

D. The state superintendent may issue a waiver relating to the number of absences for participation in any state or national competition. The state superintendent shall develop a procedure for petitioning cumulative provision eligibility cases, similar to other eligibility situations.

E. Student standards for participation in <u>interscholastic</u> extracurricular activities shall be applied beginning with a student's [second semester of grade eight] academic record in grade nine."


