16	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
17	Section 1. SEVERANCE TAX BONDSPURPOSE FOR WHICH ISSUED
18	APPROPRIATION OF PROCEEDSThe state board of finance may issue
19	and sell severance tax bonds in compliance with the Severance
20	Tax Bonding Act in an amount not exceeding one million dollars
21	(\$1,000,000) when the New Mexico office of Indian affairs
22	certifies the need for the issuance of the bonds. The state
23	board of finance shall schedule the issuance and sale of the
24	bonds in the most expeditious and economical manner possible
25	upon a finding by the board that the project has been developed

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1 sufficiently to justify the issuance and that the project can proceed to contract within a reasonable time. The state board 2 of finance shall further take the appropriate steps necessary to 3 comply with the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended. The 4 proceeds from the sale of the bonds are appropriated to the New 5 6 Mexico office of Indian affairs for the purpose of constructing phase one of a laboratory science complex at southwestern Indian 7 polytechnic institute in Albuquerque located in Bernalillo 8 9 county. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the 10 end of fiscal year 2000 shall revert to the severance tax 11 bonding fund. If the New Mexico office of Indian affairs has 12 not certified the need for the issuance of the bonds by the end 13 of fiscal year 1999, the authorization provided in this section 14 shall be void.

Section 2. EMERGENCY.--It is necessary for the public peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.
