MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR A DOMESTIC VIOLENCE PREVENTION AND
COUNSELING PROGRAM FOR THE NAVAJO NATION IN MCKINLEY AND SAN
JUAN COUNTIES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION. --Ninety-six thousand nine
hundred eighteen dollars (\$96,918) is appropriated from the
general fund to the New Mexico office of Indian affairs for
expenditure in fiscal year 1998 for the purpose of providing a
domestic violence prevention and counseling program in McKinley
and San Juan counties for the office of Navajo women and
families. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at
the end of fiscal year 1998 shall revert to the general fund.
