BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION. -- Fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the state department of public education for expenditure in fiscal year 1998 for the purpose of providing economic education instruction and other related training to elementary and secondary public schools teachers in Albuquerque. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 1998 shall revert to the general fund.
