AN ACT

RELATING TO CRIMES; DEFINING UNLAWFUL CARRYING OF A DEADLY WEAPON ON STATE PREMISES; PROVIDING A PENALTY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. A new Section 30-7-2.4 NMSA 1978 is enacted to read:

- "30-7-2.4. [NEW MATERIAL] UNLAWFUL CARRYING OF A DEADLY WEAPON ON STATE PREMISES.--
- A. Unlawful carrying of a deadly weapon on state premises consists of carrying a deadly weapon on state premises by a person other than:
- (1) a peace officer in the lawful discharge of his duties;
- (2) private security personnel hired by or under contract with the state to provide armed security; or

(3) a person older than nineteen years of age in a private automobile or other private means of conveyance for lawful protection of the person's or another's person or property.

B. As used in this section:

- (1) "state" means the state of New Mexico and any of its branches, agencies, departments, boards, commissions, instrumentalities and institutions, including higher education institutions; and
- (2) "state premises" means the buildings, together with grounds and parking areas, in or on which state activities are regularly conducted under the supervision of state management personnel.
- C. Whoever commits unlawful carrying of a deadly weapon on state premises is guilty of a fourth degree felony."
