FOR THE COURTS, CORRECTIONS AND CRIMINAL JUSTICE COMMITTEE

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE DNA IDENTIFICATION SYSTEM FUND FOR THE PURPOSE OF IMPLEMENTING THE PROVISIONS OF THE DNA IDENTIFICATION ACT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION. -- One million dollars

(\$1,000,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the DNA identification system fund for expenditure in fiscal year 1998 for the purpose of implementing the provisions of the DNA Identification Act, contingent upon enactment of Senate Bill 114 by the first session of the forty-third legislature. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 1998 shall not revert to the general fund.
