AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO PROVIDE ADULT LITERACY SERVICES THROUGHOUT THE STATE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

APPROPRIATION. -- One hundred thousand dollars Section 1. (\$100,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the library division of the office of cultural affairs for expenditure in fiscal year 1998 for the purpose of contracting with a statewide nonprofit adult literacy organization to promote, coordinate and enhance adult and intergenerational literacy opportunities and services throughout the state. This appropriation is designated for training, technical assistance and operating support for volunteer-based literacy programs statewide, emphasizing activities designed to interrupt intergenerational cycles of illiteracy and to promote public and private partnerships to

address the challenge of illiteracy in New Mexico. unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 1998 shall revert to the general fund.
